Understanding Our "No Floor" Building Option

Customers often ask why choosing a no floor option for a portable building costs more than a standard model with a floor. It is a very logical question, as it seems like less material should mean a lower price. However, the cost difference is based entirely on the manufacturing process and logistical requirements, rather than just the materials used.

Here is a detailed breakdown of why a premium applies to floorless builds and what to expect during installation.

1. The Manufacturing Process

Because our manufacturing process is standardized for peak efficiency, a floorless unit requires a complete departure from our normal workflow. Without a standard floor to tie the walls together, our builders must install extensive temporary bracing. This extra bracing ensures the building remains perfectly square and stable during the entire construction phase.

2. Logistics and Transportation

Moving a floorless unit is significantly more complex. We have to travel at slower speeds on the highway to maintain the structural integrity of the shell. Additionally, loading and unloading these custom units takes considerably more time and precision compared to a standard floored shed.

3. Delivery and Site Access

Since these custom units lack standard skids underneath, our specialized Shed Mule equipment usually cannot be used for placement. This means our delivery team must be able to back the truck and trailer directly up to your concrete pad for a successful installation.

4. Service Area Limitations for Custom Builds

Please note that while we proudly deliver our standard portable buildings across the entire state of Wisconsin, Minnesota, the Upper Peninsula of Michigan, parts of Northern Illinois, and Iowa, we only offer the custom "no floor" installation service within the state of Wisconsin. This restriction ensures we can maintain the high level of quality control and specialized logistical support required for these complex installations.

Important Details for Your Installation

- **Anchoring:** We include anchoring the building securely to your concrete slab as part of the setup process once the unit is in place.
- **Sill Seal:** If you would like a sill seal installed underneath the green treated 2x6 base plates, please provide that material to our team ahead of our arrival.
- **Site Clearance:** Please ensure the path to your concrete pad is completely clear and accessible for a full size truck and trailer.
